

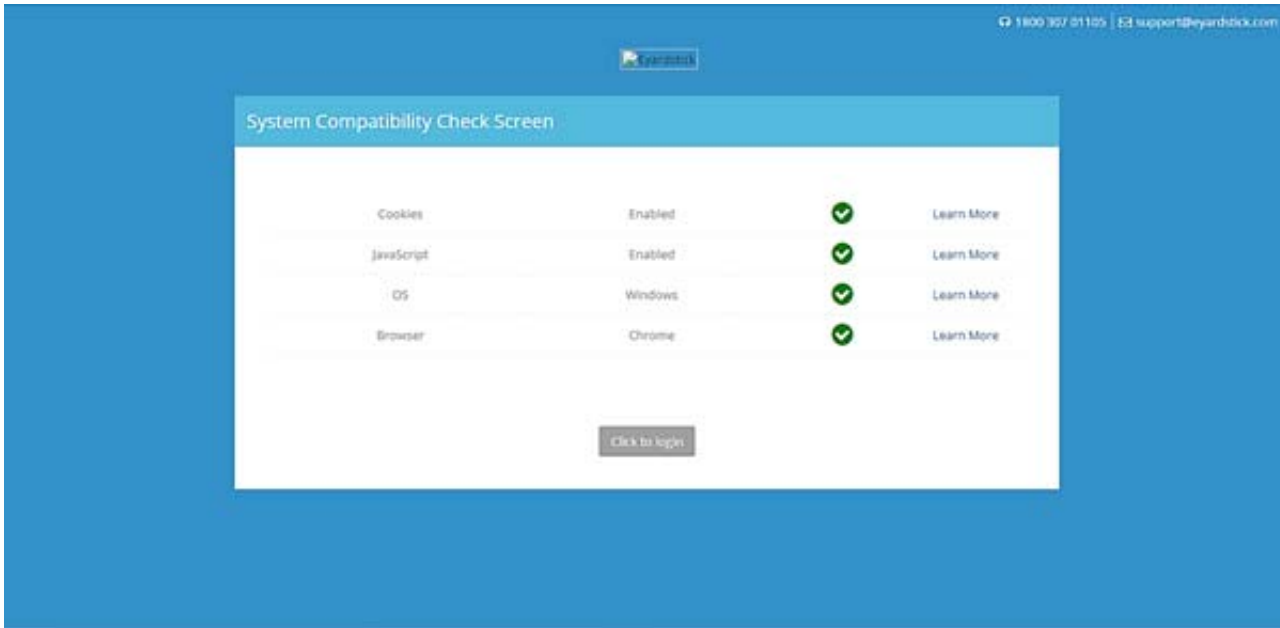
# Eyardstick Exam screens explained

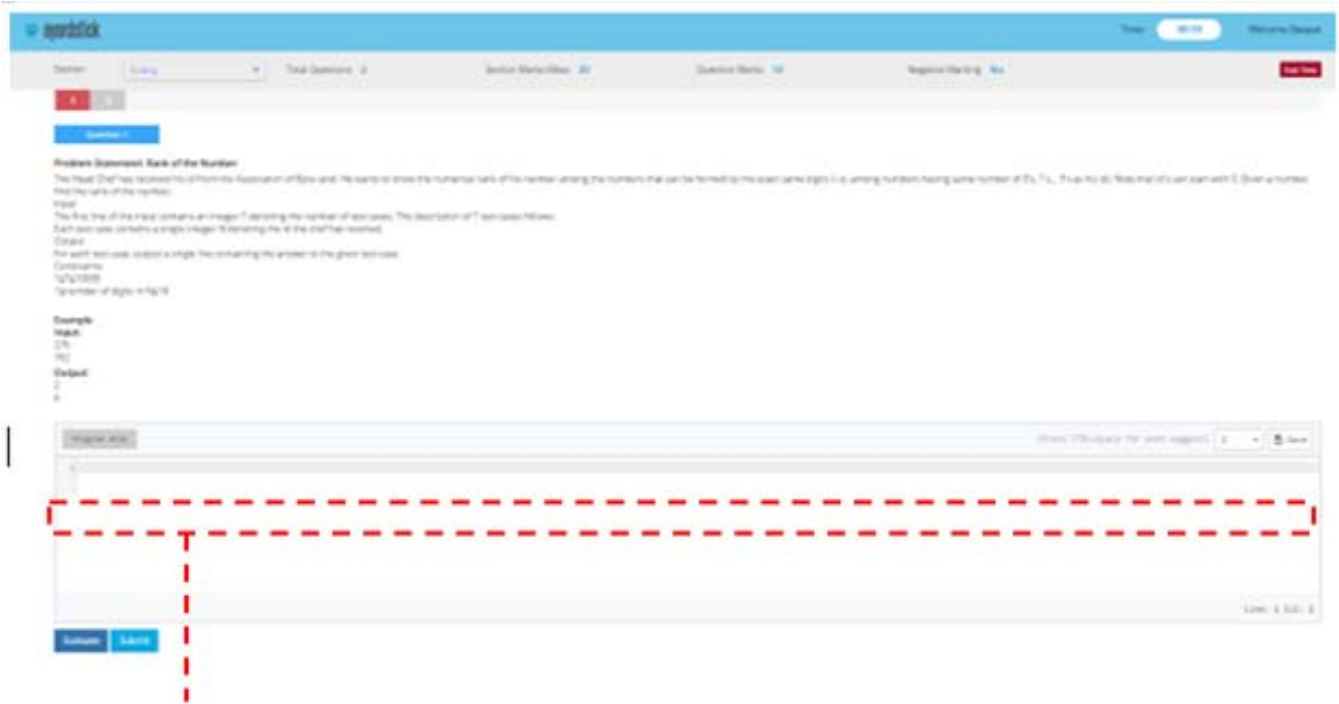
## 6. TEST SCREEN (MCQ SECTION):

### The important things to note:

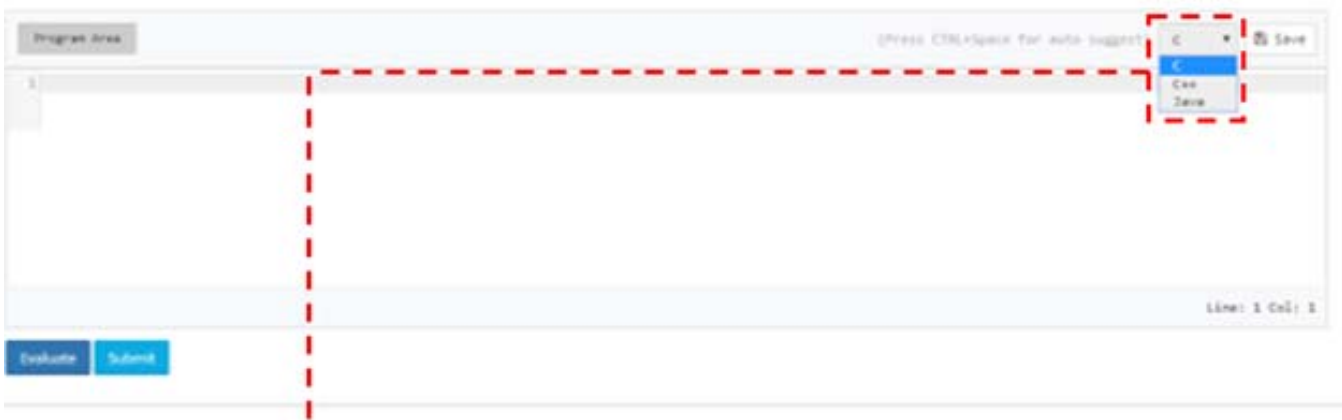
- 1 **Timer:** This counts down to the end of the test. Keep track of this as you progress in the test, and make sure you move at an optimal speed.
